MOTORCYCLE ACCIDENTS

As increasing numbers of motorcycles have taken to the roadways for commuting and pleasure. Approximately 100,000 motorcyclists are injured in the United States each year, and nearly 4,500 deaths are caused by collisions between motorcycles and motor vehicles annually.

If you have suffered a serious injury in a motorcycle accident, or a loved one has died due the negligence of another party, you may be entitled to file a personal injury lawsuit. Financial compensation has been awarded to plaintiffs involved in cases where:

- A vehicle driver was speeding, driving recklessly, failed to signal, violated the rules of the road, or failed to yield.
- A vehicle driver was under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- A motorcyclist was injured due to defects in the road, potholes, trap doors or hidden openings, grates and sewers, manhole covers and utility vaults, construction plates, road cuts, trenches, or other temporary paving issues.
- A motorcyclist was not adequately warned of a road hazard.
- Construction debris, demolition equipment, dumpsters, or other equipment placed negligently that caused a motorcyclist's accident.
